REASON FOR LIFE CYCLE UPDATE

Bosch Security Systems Software License Manager web portal
(<https://activation.boschsecurity.com>) will be shut down effectively 1st of October 2026.

As a result, any further licensing-related actions (activating new licenses, upgrade, generating Maintenance Report) will not be directly possible for all the BVMS systems, which were not yet upgraded to BVMS 11.0 or higher – BVMS 11.0 and higher versions are using Remote Portal which will remain the standard license management portal.

To prepare for this change, we strongly recommend upgrading all the existing licenses to BVMS 11.0 or higher, even if the actual software version would remain as is for the time being. This step will ensure that the licensing information remains available (after migrating to Remote Portal) so the customer can seamlessly use those licenses as soon as BVMS is updated to version 11.0 or higher. Additionally, please ensure that the system is covered with Software Maintenance Agreement to allow upgrade to BVMS 11.0 or higher.

Please note, that any licenses activated before, using the Software License Manager portal, can still be used in BVMS software and remain valid until the system configuration changes – which might be result of upgrading the software version, adding new devices to the configuration or changing the server hardware.

UNTIL 30TH OF SEPTEMBER 2026

As long as the Software License Manager portal is still available, customers can perform the following actions:

- Upgrading the BVMS software version, including upgrade to BVMS 11.0+
- Generating Maintenance Agreement Report, allowing extension of SMA
- Overview of all the licenses activated under specific account in the past

It is also possible to still activate licenses (for instance, if additional spare licenses were purchased in the past), however, according to our [Software Service and Support Policy](#), all the licenses for BVMS 10.1 or lower are EOL and not available for sales anymore.

FROM 1ST OF OCTOBER 2026

Bosch Security Systems Software License Manager web portal will be shut down and access to it will not be possible anymore. Information about licenses that were not yet migrated will be stored, but it will not be possible anymore to access it directly by customers. Any further actions related to licenses that were not yet migrated to Remote Portal, will require assistance of IQSIGHT tech support.

Points below summarize actions possible and not possible anymore for all the licenses of BVMS versions up to 10.1:

1. Possible with **tech support assistance**:
 - Upgrading licenses to BVMS 11.0+ and retrieve license code to be activated in Remote Portal
2. Possible with **license ordering**:
 - Extending SMA to allow activation for BVMS 11.0+ even if previous SMA end date wouldn't allow it (for example: old system with SMA expired in 2017)
Note: if customer does not have a Maintenance Extension Report generated upfront, additional step will be required to validate correct SMA items to be purchased with the IQSIGHT team
3. **Not possible** anymore:
 - Activating any licenses or expansions for BVMS versions up to 10.1
 - Overview of licenses that were not migrated to BVMS 11.0+
 - Upgrading to any BVMS version below 11.0 (e.g. from 8.0 to 10.0)

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

To prepare for the upcoming changes, we strongly recommend performing the following actions:

- Migrate existing BVMS licenses to Remote Portal by upgrading at least to BVMS 11.0 – even if you plan to perform the actual software upgrade at a later stage
- Note down key information, that might help to retrieve licensing information for your systems in future, specifically:
 - Hardware ID (also called “System Identifier”) either in your Software License Manager account or by opening License Manager in BVMS Configuration Client
 - The account (E-mail address) used for managing licenses in the Bosch Security Systems Software License Manager
- Generate Maintenance Extension Reports for all your systems using the Software License Manager

- If not available yet, create your Remote Portal account which will be used later to manage BVMS 11.0+ licenses (Note: there will be no migration of user accounts from the Software License Manager system to Remote Portal)
- If you still have any BVMS expansion licenses for any BVMS of version 10.1 or older (including DIVAR IP specific license types ...-DIP) please make sure to activate those before end of September – afterwards, it will no longer be possible.

Further, detailed instructions on license handling after October 1st 2026 will be provided by the end of August 2026 latest. Nevertheless, we would like to again recommend starting to prepare for this change in advance.
